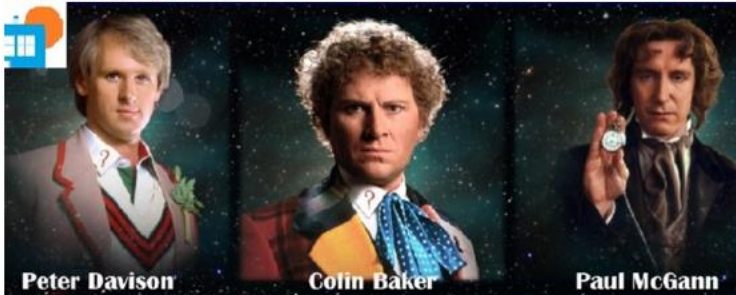

A rare occurrence not to be missed the [L. I. Who Convention](#) will have three previous Doctors at the same event: The Eighth Doctor, Paul McGann and the Sixth Doctor, Colin Baker. The Fifth Doctor, Peter Davison is attending L.I. Who for the first time. Other popular guests range from Sophie Aldred who played the faithful companion Dorothy Gale "Ace" McShane, along with more recent characters such as Jemma Redgrave, who plays Commander Kate Lethbridge-Stewart in the current series. Several other Doctor Who characters are [scheduled to appear](#).

Guests will also have the chance to see the beautiful Eighth Doctor's TARDIS Console up close for the first time ever on the East Coast. This majestic wooden console with a steam punk feel seen in the Eighth Doctor's TV movie, will be available for photo opportunities throughout the weekend. This is the first ever appearance of this piece of Dr. Who history on the East Coast and on Long Island. Sci-Fi Photo Guys will be on-site to help to speed up the photo process and add some wonderful surprises to make everyone's photo op unique.

This year the convention expects to have nearly 2,000 attendees, almost double the previous attendance. Last year attendees traveled from 48 of the 50 United States and many foreign countries including the United Kingdom, Canada, Australia, and Pakistan.

L.I. Who will have three full days of programming, with events starting on Friday, Veteran's Day, Nov. 11th with a tribute to Long Islanders who have served in the armed forces and continuing all weekend with over 200 hours of Doctor Who fan discussion panels, interviews with celebrities, cosplay, gaming, and kids programming.

Tickets are still available in limited numbers. Weekend tickets are \$95 for an adult and \$79 for a child. There are single day passes for Friday (\$45 adult, \$25 child); Saturday (\$60 adult, \$35 child) and Sunday (\$40 adult, \$19 child). Tickets can be found at www.longislanddoctorwho.com
