When people think about a visit to Long Island, they typically think of warm weather, beaches and sunshine. But now is a perfect time to visit (or plan a staycation) to beat the winter doldrums.

Hotels are offering **special hotel packages** that combine a stay with several fun options. You could book a romantic and relaxing package that include spa services; or bring the whole family for a weekend that combines admission tickets to the local aquarium or children's museum.

The wineries are open year-round and a romantic trip to wine country is a great way to explore that region before the crowds of summer come pouring in. Several hotels offer overnight stays that include a wine tour and tastings. And for the especially hardy, you can book a golf weekend getaway and practice your shots before the summer starts.

Want to plan your own getaway that combines a hotel stay with a local attraction. Find **things to do here**. Or you can just keep it simple and make a plan to get together with family and/or friends for a **'Pool Party Weekend.'** You find a hotel with an indoor pool and restaurant where you can shut out the cold and snow and relax in comfort. Order in, watch a movie, take a swim, enjoy the hot tub.

Want to get away with some friends? Book a **Spa-jama Getaway** at the Inn and Spa at East Wind. The Hampton Inn Garden City **Family Fun Package for Four**, includes four tickets to the Long Island Children's Museum, located just one mile from the Hampton Inn Garden City, and overnight accommodations.
